- 2 A subject This is the noun or pronoun performing the action in the clause Example The house where I grew up is now a museum
- 2 Relative adverb where Subject I Verb grew up
- 3 Types of Adjective Clauses

Restrictive vs Nonrestrictive

Adjective clauses are categorized into two main types based on their function and punctuation

A Restrictive Clauses

These clauses are essential to the meaning of the sentence They define or limit the noun they modify making them indispensable They are not set off by commas Example The student who cheated on the exam failed the course Removing who cheated on the exam changes the meaning entirely Its not just any student who failed but specifically the one who cheated

B Nonrestrictive Clauses

These clauses add extra information about the noun they modify but this information is not essential to the sentences core meaning They are set off by commas Example My dog who is a golden retriever loves to play fetch The information about the dogs breed is extra the sentences core meaning My dog loves to play fetch remains intact even without it

4 Relative Pronouns and Their Usage

Choosing the correct relative pronoun is crucial for clarity and grammatical accuracy Heres a breakdown

- Who/Whom** Refer to people Who is the subjective case performs the action while whom is the objective case receives the action Example Who The woman who wrote the novel won an award Example Whom The author whom I interviewed was very insightful

- Which** Refers to things or animals Example The book which I read last week was amazing
